- Addition of the Mental Wellbeing Assessment benefit All members
  have access to the Mental Wellbeing Assessment on the Discovery Health
  app with a risk-funded benefit for a consultation with a GP or psychologist
  for members with a mental health risk.
- One risk funded virtual consultation with a GP for urgent care per family per annum via the Discovery Health app
- Coordination of care to promote quality of care and improved health outcomes:
  - Members registered on the Chronic Illness Benefit should visit their nominated GP for chronic consultations to avoid a 20% co-payment on the consultation
  - The allowance for the allocation of a secondary GP has been removed
  - KeyCare out-of-network GP benefit has been replaced with one nurseled consultation at a network pharmacy clinic with a GP referral if needed
- **KeyCare Hospital Network has been optimised for 2024** inefficient hospitals have been removed where there are alternative hospitals within a reasonable distance and new hospitals have been added to the network.
- Introduction of the Home-based Hospital Network as a DSP for specific low acuity conditions if the member meets the eligibility criteria
- Elective tonsillectomies, myringotomies and adenoidectomies will be added to the KeyCare exclusion list. PMB procedures will still be covered in full.


## Value of the KeyCare series

The KeyCare series continues to offer competitive and highly valued benefits at a low price point – 5.2% more affordable than the next 7 largest open medical schemes

#### **KeyCare benefit differentiators:**

- Unlimited **hospital cover** in KeyCare Network Hospitals
  - All mental health admissions covered in full at a network facility
  - No limit on neonatal intensive care, high care or intensive care
  - No limit on HIV-related admissions
- Comprehensive day-to-day benefits including:
  - Unlimited GP cover with pre-auth only required after the 15<sup>th</sup> GP visit
  - Specialist cover up to R5 000 per annum on KeyCare Plus
  - Comprehensive maternity benefits including: 8 pre-natal consultations, 2 ultrasound scans, necessary blood tests, 2 post-natal GP/Specialist consultations, a breastfeeding consultation, access to a dietician, 2 mental healthcare consultations, up to 5 antenatal/postnatal classes or consultations
  - Casualty cover with after-hours care at select KeyCare Start GPs and cover for one visit in any casualty unit at one of the KeyCare network hospitals for KeyCare Plus
  - Access to the Mental Wellbeing Assessment and risk funded benefits for the diagnosis and treatment of mental health conditions
  - 12-15 out-of-hospital mental health consultations for a list of disorders
